Nashville Musicians Association Crisis Assistance Fund

Nashville Musicians AFM Local 257 is a 501C3 fund created after the 2010 Nashville Flood and is now renamed and reactivated. It is open for donations to be distributed to musicians impacted by Covid-19. Donations are tax-deductible and will help musicians who have lost work and need financial assistance.

MusiCares COVID-19 Relief Fund

Has expanded their services to include lost income due to the cancellation of scheduled gigs or performances due to Coronavirus/COVID-19 precautionary measures.

Independent Music United Nashville (IMUN)

Recently formed by singer/songwriter Meghan Haynes for musicians and music biz affiliates to help each other get through the Coronavirus Pandemic by engaging with local and state legislators to petition for assistance/relief.
